Trainers are people who deal with discrimination and its consequences in everyday life and provide a very practical approach

Target groups: teachers/ trainers, public administration officers

Focus: special provisions for improving gender equality in schools, public administration offices , hospitals and other health centres

Methodology:

- modular training course aimed at psycho-socio-health operators that analyses the LGBTQ theme, created with tools and methodologies able to both strengthen the theoretical-practical knowledge and skills on homosexuality and transgender identity, and to influence attitudes and prejudices
- the training content is created following a training needs analysis
- based on three lines of action: information, training, consultancy
- trainers are professionals (psychologists, counsellors, lawyers) and LGBTQ activists
- participation of different advocacy groups brings the contribution of different perspectives

Impact: A quality impact measurement will be made at the end of the project collecting input and evaluation from participants.

Conclusion: Schools, institutions and public administration participating in the project will benefit from new competences and information and will be able to develop a more inclusive approach in their daily activities and programmes.
